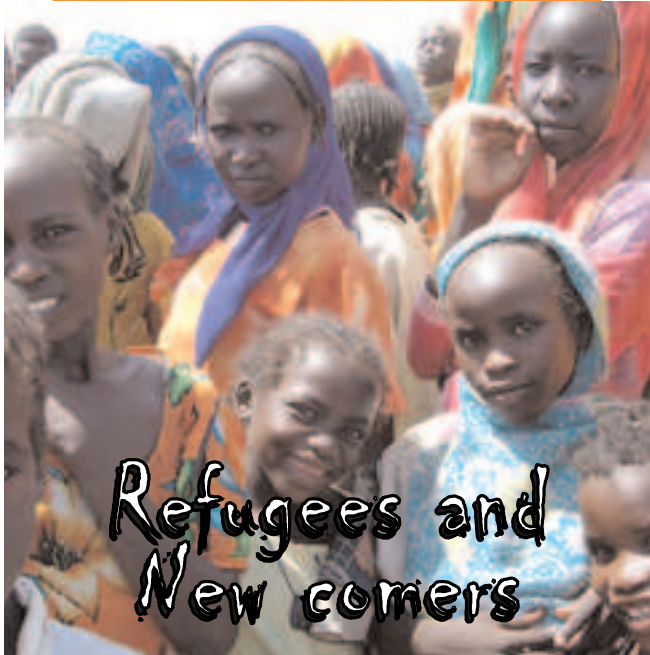


How does it work?

I. Refugee and New Comers

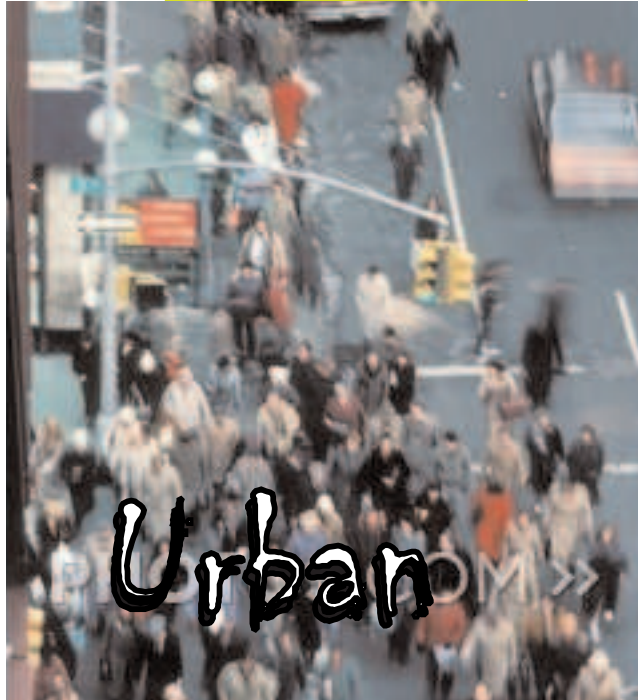
