Drought, cyclones, earthquakes, floods and now rising food costs. Millions of the world's poorest people don't have enough to eat and the numbers are rapidly growing. MCC is responding where the needs are greatest.

› MCC's response

MCC food programs include emergency food assistance and long-term water and agriculture projects. MCC also works with community groups and governments to ensure that the voices of the poor and the hungry are heard.

MCC workers report that requests for food assistance are soaring. In the past few months MCC has responded in countries including Ethiopia, Sudan, India, Burundi and Kenya.

› Urgent needs

Maasai families in Kenya are feeling the impacts of a changing climate as they cope with prolonged drought. MCC is providing emergency food assistance to 3,000 families and 7,000 primary school students. MCC's partners report that the price of food items is two to three times higher than normal.

Drought and hyper-inflation continue to fuel the food crisis in Zimbabwe where MCC is helping the Brethren in Christ Church feed more than 7,000 high school students and their teachers.
